




ACADEMIC CALENDAR AND DATES

ELIGIBILITY FOR EXCHANGE

Inter-institutional agreement	There should be an inter-institutional agreement for Student Mobility for Study (SMS) between the home university and Wageningen University & Research.	
Registration	Exchange students should be registered as a regular student at one of the partner universities.	
General course requirements	A minimum of 120 ECTS should have been completed before the exchange, which equals at least two years of study at the home university/academic background.	
English proficiency (minimum scores)	TOEFL internet-based: 80 IELTS : 6.0 Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English: C Cambridge First Certificate: B Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English: C German Abitur: 06 Belgian ADO or TSO: 60 International Baccalauréat: 3

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The application deadline is 1 May for students who start their exchange in September. For students who start in January or later, the application deadline is 15 October. Students have to be nominated for exchange by the coordinator from the home university.

There is a very limited number of rooms through Wageningen university & Research available for exchange students. Therefore, only exchange students who need a visa/residence permit for The Netherlands will receive housing through Wageningen University & Research. They will automatically be invited for this.

IMMIGRATION INFORMATION

For some incoming students, Wageningen University & Research needs to apply for a MVV entry visa and/or residence permit(VVR) after admittance (students should not start procedures themselves). The International Office of the Student Service Centre (SSC) from Wageningen University & Research will send the application for entry visa (MVV) and/or residence permit (VVR) to the immigration authorities (IND). The dues for this procedure are 317 Euros (2017). In this table can be checked which permit(s) are needed.


