tasks: introducing students to their nature environment, its values and benefits; introducing students to basic ecological principles in the field to complement their school curricula; increasing student interest in the natural world; listing benefits of their nature environment; explaining several ecological principles; identifying several common plants and animals in their nature environment and their adaptations to the environment; some of the activities will be: drawing or writing about plants and insects around the students' school and home, listing animal life that fed or took shelter in a local tree, constructing a food web, identifying environmental problems and possible solutions.
