“..... the blurring of boundaries between map producers and map consumers”


“..... the availability of data and tools allows these neocartographers to make their own maps, and often be the intended audience as well – that is to say they may make the maps for themselves, just because they can”

“Crowdsourcing is the act of sourcing tasks traditionally performed by specific individuals to a group of people or community (crowd) through an open call.”






























Fig. 4: Bar diagram showing the level of experience with maps among the CAMP attendees
