

## Social scholarship

## Article 1

Two main conditions must be met for the scholarship to be granted:

- The Social scholarship of the Department of Development Studies (DDS) can be awarded only to a first or second-year student of International Development Studies master programme at the Faculty of Science, Palacký University in Olomouc (further only IDS).
- 2. The Social scholarship can be awarded only to citizens of least developed countries according to the UN definition<sup>1</sup> or to the citizens of programme and project priority countries of the Czech development cooperation according to the Czech Development Agency<sup>2</sup>.

## Article 2

In order to be considered a valid candidate for the scholarship, student must first apply for the scholarship. The explanation on why he/she needs the scholarship shall be part of the written application. The application form is then handed over to the DDS employee who is responsible for the IDS administration. The application has to be approved or rejected within 30 working days since its submission and the student shall be immediately informed about the decision. The Social scholarship can be applied for only once in an academic year.

## Article 3

The amount of the scholarship corresponds to 1/3 of the yearly annual tuition fee for the IDS master programme. The Social scholarship is sent to students within 30 working days from the end of academic year during which the application was submitted.
