

**SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR ERASMUS STUDY STAY AT BEIT BERL COLLEGE
(ISRAEL)
FOR SUMMER SEMESTER OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2016–2017**

Department of Development Studies opens a call for applications for study stay at Beit Berl College in Israel during summer semester 2017. This study stay is open only to Master students and it is supported by the ERASMUS+ grant that partly covers the living costs in Israel (approximately 650€/month). The students on another Erasmus+ program scholarship (e.g. Erasmus Mundus) are not eligible for this grant but still can apply for the study period abroad.

The students are encouraged to go through the website of the college and search for appropriate courses that might be compatible with their study program at Palacky University. Students are free to choose from the whole offer of the English taught courses.

Requirements for participation in the interview

All candidates are required to send the documents specified below to volenikova.l@gmail.com by **Wednesday 5th October (20:00)** at the latest. Please notice that all documents must be submitted in PDF in RAR or ZIP folder. The folder must be named according to the candidate.

(A) CV

- In English
- Length: one page

(B) Proof of academic results

- Proof (e.g. STAG printout, Transcript of Records) of academic results and study averages for all completed years of study (including bachelor programs for master students)

(C) Motivation letter

- In English
- Length: max. 400 words

(D) Proposed study plan – optional

- You may prepare a draft of the proposed study plan.

Interview

- Interviews will take place on **6th October at 11.00** at the premises of the Department of Development Studies (wait in front of the rooms 2027 and 2029).
- Interview may be partly carried out in English.
