# ADDITIONAL SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR ERASMUS STUDY STAYS IN SUMMER SEMESTER OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2016–2017

- If you apply for university in more than one category (A, B, C), send more CVs in respective languages (max. 3).
- Length: one page

#### (B) Proof of academic results

 Proof (e.g. STAG printout, Transcript of Records) of academic results and study averages for all completed years of study (including bachelor programs for master students)

#### (C) Motivation letter

- A for Utrecht, Ghent, Malmö, Warsaw, Brighton, Trondheim and Turin in English language
- B for Brussels, Clermont-Ferrand, Montpellier, Grenoble, Antilles (Martinique) and New Caledonia in French language
- C for Madrid, Granada, Las Palmas and Alicante in Spanish language
- If you apply for more universities, clearly specify your order of preferences.
- If you apply for university in more than one category (A, B, C), send more motivation letters in respective languages (max. 3); if you apply for more universities within one category (e.g. category A), write just one motivation letter (for a given category).
- Length: max. 400 words

Study stays in **Brighton, Brussels, Grenoble, Madrid, Granada, Alicante, Malaga** and **Warsaw** are mainly for master students. The acceptance of bachelor students is possible, but depends on the decision of the receiving institution. If accepted, the students have to take into consideration that most of the courses are at the master level.
